### JOB ANNOUNCEMENT For Field Services Supervisor

Supervisory Position  
FLSA Exempt

The Merced County Mosquito Abatement District is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Field Services Supervisor. Under the direction of the General Manager the Field Services Supervisor (FSS) plans, organizes and directs all field activities, facility management, and vehicle and equipment maintenance. The FSS shall supervise the Control Technician II, Control Technician/Maintenance positions, Control Technicians, Seasonal Operators and any other personnel involved with the ground operations of the District. The FSS will implement the General Manager's policies for treatment and control of mosquitoes and assign personnel to complete adulticiding and larviciding treatments. Additionally, the FSS will act as District Safety Officer. The FSS will insure employee compliance with CalOSHA and CalDPR regulations. The FSS will conduct annual training of District personnel for chemical handling, pesticide labels, equipment operation, and other safety related themes. The FSS will also complete equipment calibration and droplet analysis of ground spray equipment. The Field Services Supervisor and Environmental Services Supervisor will jointly conduct annual performance reviews for employees under their supervision.

Education: High School diploma. College level course work leading to completion of a Bachelor's Degree or Associate's Degree is desirable. Possession of a mosquito control certificate from the California Department of Health services or obtain certification within a 1-year probationary period.

Experience: At least six years of increasingly responsible experience in mosquito control or similar supervision experience preferably for a government entity performing a full range of services.

Compensation: \$65,894.40 Range 70.9 Step 5 of the Merced County Salary Schedule

Benefits: Health Insurance, Paid Holidays, Sick Leave, Vacation, Management Leave, Retirement, and Worker's Compensation Insurance

Probation: Individual appointed to this position shall be subject to a 1-year probationary period
