Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District is looking for qualified applicants to fill numerous job openings for entry level, seasonal vector control technicians. These technicians work under the supervision of a licensed vector control technician to implement Integrated Vector Management practices to protect residents of Northwest Riverside County. Assigned duties include:

- Identifying, removing, or treating sources where mosquitoes develop
- Keep written and electronic records as indicated for work performed
- Assist in receiving and maintaining inventories
- Attend training sessions and completes learning assignments in vector control
- Assist in maintenance of District headquarters

Working conditions require the technician have the ability to:

- Practice safety and sound judgement
- Traverse uneven ground
- Bend at the knees and waist to inspect mosquito breeding sources
- Carry 40 pounds, perform repetitive motion activities
- Operate a full-size vehicle
- Sit for extended periods of time

Qualifications:

Possession of current valid California driver's license is required. Employees in this position will be enrolled in the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Government Employer Pull Notice Program which confirms possession of valid driver's license and reflects driving records during course of employment with Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District. Employment contingent upon having a driving record acceptable to the District and insurer.

Post Offer Physical Examination:

All persons selected for appointment must pass a medical examination administered by the District designated physician. Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control District is committed to maintain a drug and alcohol-free workplace.
